Cat Trailer Weekly Shift, AM or PM—Get up close and personal with our cats. Unless they are ill, new to the environment, or have difficulty adjusting, our cats have free rein over their shelter as well as a screened-in outdoor enclosure. They are cared for twice daily by volunteers. Duties include cleaning litter boxes, providing fresh water, keeping food bowls full, changing bedding and other linens as needed, checking for possible illnesses, sweeping and cleaning as necessary, and, of course, playing with our kitties. Most of our cats also enjoy being groomed if you have the time or desire during your shift. Expect to spend about 1.5 hours and select either a morning shift (7-10 a.m.) or an evening shift (4-7 p.m.). Cat Trailer Deep Clean—About once a month, we do a thorough cleaning of the trailer, including walls, windows, and floors, washing out litter boxes, and so forth. Kitty Laundry—We need volunteers to pick up one or more bags of laundry outside the cat trailer each week, or even just twice a month, and then bring it back when clean. We'll even supply the detergent and bleach, if you need it. Contact Mary Martha Rose, 252-638-0136, mary.m.rose@jones.nc.gov.

Pet Transport—To give people a chance to see and adopt our cats, several are taken to Petsense on Glenburnie Road each week and the ones who were there are brought back to the shelter. You would be working with another volunteer. Contact Mary Martha Rose, 252-638-0136, mary.m.rose@jones.nc.gov.

Foster Parent—Our very young kittens, cats with adjustment difficulties, and all of our dogs are in foster care. Apply to be a foster parent by filling out a form that is available at www.colonialcapital.org. We appreciate your patience after you submit your application, as it can take several weeks for a volunteer to get back to you.

Adopt-a-thons—Once or twice each month, CCHS holds an adopt-a-thon on a Saturday, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Petsense in New Bern. You would stay with us and help to handle any issues that arise--a dog that needs walking, an emergency clean-up, direct people who have questions to another volunteer (or, after you learn more, answer them yourself), and possibly transporting animals to and from the adopt-a-thon.
